

Kerala Police Annual Games and Athletic Meet 2016

The logo of 45th Kerala Police Annual Games and Athletic meet 2016 have been released by Shri Loknath Behara, IPS(State Police Chief, Kerala) at KAP IV Battalion in a function attended by Shri Nithin Agrawal,IPS (ADGP AP Bn.), Shri Dinendra Kashyap, IPS (Vice Chairman, Organizing Committee), Shri K.
